Training Guidelines & Protections

ILEAS Auditorium

- 1. Students should report to the training site with a <u>mask</u> and <u>writing pen</u>.
- 2. All students must be registered to attend.
- 3. Students should stay home if they are experiencing flu-like symptoms.
- 4. Room capacity will be limited to 50 persons, including staff and instructors.
- 5. The Auditorium will be set to ensure 6 feet physical distancing between all students.
- 6. Students shall wear masks at all times when inside the ILEAS facility.
