

# ILEAS Executive Director Status Report June 29, 2005

# Membership

The membership rate has slowed, but not stopped, since the grants closed. Additionally, there are 496 completed alarm cards and an additional 110 cards that have been started but not finished.

The significant increase in membership has dropped off since the grant period closed. Chicago has sent in their agreement.

#### **Grants**

The grant process is moving forward rapidly. Grant agreements have been mailed and most of them have been returned. In order to facilitate the spending of the ICLEAR MDC funds by the end of August, ILEAS is buying the MDC's directly from the vendor and shipping them to the agencies. So far, three PO's have been issued for a total of \$1,870,950. We are already starting to receive invoices from other grants.

Given that State University police departments were not eligible for ILEAS grants, ITTF conducted one round of grant applications from them. Mike Chamness asked ILEAS if they could utilize the online grant application process. ILEAS reopened the online grants for most of the month of June. At the ILEAS Board meeting on June 29<sup>th</sup>, the Grant committee met, reviewed the applications and made recommendations. The applications and recommendations were sent to ITTF for their approval.

## VHF/StarCom21 Radios

476 agencies requested VHF radios. We ordered 500 of them. They will be shipped later in the fall.

# **Regional Distribution Site Security Teams**

Based, on Chief Swanson's work, Jim Luecking pulled together a meeting of team commanders and experts from Urbana, Winnebago County, NIPAS, Chicago and ISP. It will be held on August 9, 2005 in Olympia Fields.

## SRT Training

On Thursday, July 14<sup>th</sup>, we submitted the first request for the NIPAS Basic SWAT class to obtain OPD certification so that we can spend training funds on it. More to follow as it happens. The NIPAS basic SWAT class for southern Illinois is underway at this time. They have basic HAZMAT Operations next month.

ILEAS has met with IFSI staff to develop and get certified a law enforcement respirator certification course that is tailored to what the SRT's need. More to follow on this - however, there will be development costs that IFSI staff will charge.

# **SRT Equipment/Budget**

The remainder of the large ticket items have been ordered. The existing teams are doing one last review to ensure that they have everything. We continue to get equipment shipped and delivered.
