

Additional Federal FY15 Grant

Approximately one month ago, ITTF Chair Mike Chamness notified the ITTF Council of Chairs that approximately \$600,000 was available in unspent Federal FY15 funds. Each Committee was to propose a project that was specifically tied to the Unmet Needs report. ILEAS proposed several possibilities. At the March 28th Council of Chairs meeting, the ITTF approved a project for ILEAS to begin the replacement of respirators for special teams. Many of the teams are using the same respirators that were issued as far back as 2004/2005 and are long past their expiration date. The grant paperwork is expected to be completed any day now. Everything purchased pursuant to this grant MUST be delivered by August 31, 2018. Executive Director Page has altered that timeline so that anything purchased should be done by June 30. The reason being that anything submitted after July 1st, will not be paid until the first of November which is a huge cash flow issue for ILEAS.

Requested Board Action

The staff requests that the Governing Board approve the acceptance of the additional FFY15 grant for \$119,535.

Respirator Purchase

As stated above, ILEAS requested – and was approved for - the additional Federal FY15 grant funds to be spent on the capital replacement project for respirator rotation. Additionally, ILEAS is reaching the end of the fiscal year and has other grant funds that needs to be expended prior to June 30th. Some are projects staff has waited on, some come from unspent:

- Overtime/backfill
- Validation exercise salaries
- Regional training salaries
- Staff travel
- UASI special teams funds

As a result, staff has determined that replacing as many of the current respirators as possible for all the special teams is a worthwhile capital replacement project that ILEAS can now afford given the timing and the availability of the new and remaining money.

According to ILEAS policy, the Board must approve the purchase of items over \$100,000 which is the case for both of these acquisitions.

Here is the breakdown of the respirator proposals:

FM-54 Respirators for WMD Special Response Teams

The first priority would be the WMD SRT APR systems. The newest evolution of the masks utilized with the current respirator systems are the FM 54's, produced by AVON. These respirators would replace the FM 53's currently in use by the WMD SRT Teams that ILEAS supports.

The advantage to the FM 54's are that they have been re-engineered to move the voice projection unit within the mask, to remedy a design flaw that has caused multiple failures in the previous design. This flaw has caused multiple FM 53 units to fail in the recent past. The FM 54's are passing through the final approval phases of testing, and have been approved by the U.S. Army as the respirator of choice for their WMD units.

The quote provided to ILEAS is for approximately \$1,200 per unit. We propose the purchase of 320 of these FM54 respirators for an approximate total of \$380,000. This would equip virtually every member of the WMD SRT Teams supported by ILEAS.

C-50 Respirators for Mobile Field Force Teams

The newly received \$119,535 Federal FY15 grant funds described above will be spent on new respirators for the Mobile Field Force Teams. Some of them are using the same masks they were originally issued in 2005/2006 – which is two years over their technical expiration dates. The proposal is to purchase 361 respirators with this \$119,535.

Requested Board Action

The staff requests that the Governing Board approve the purchase of:

- 361 C50 Respirators for \$119,535, and
- 320 FM54 Respirators for \$380,000

Other Special Teams Equipment Purchases

As stated above, the Board must approve purchases of over \$100,000. This project is under that amount but close enough that while the Board is available and in the interest of transparency, they are being added to the agenda for approval. Here are the items requested:

Atlantic Bone Conduction Headsets

The last major item for purchase that I am requesting are 50 of the Atlantic brand bone conduction headsets to improve communications for the WMD SRT Teams. The current communication headsets being utilized by the WMD SRT Teams have begun to deteriorate to the point that multiple headsets have required repair on a painfully regular basis. Replacing these units has become a priority, due to the vital importance of effective communication during operations and training for these teams.

The Atlantic headsets are approximately \$1850.00 per unit. To purchase 50 of these units would be a grand total of approximately \$93,000.

Requested Board Action

The staff requests that the Governing Board approve the purchase of 50 Atlantic Bone Conduction Headsets at a cost of \$93,000.

IL Coroners' Training Board Contract

ILEAS was approached by the newly formed Illinois Coroners' Training Board (ICTB) to explore the possibility of ILEAS creating an online membership system connected to our Learning Management System (LMS). They are a brand new State Board with minimal amounts of funding. Instead of hiring their own IT staff and spending all their training funds on "classroom" style training, they instead are interested in starting out as digital as possible.

ILEAS and the ICTB discussed this for several months and finally agreed to specific contract language. The contract is in your Board packet. The ICTB met the week of April 9th and approved the contract for their part. The contract stipulates:

ILEAS will do:

- Software and web development
- Server hosting and bandwidth
- Web maintenance
- Access to LMS

ICTB will pay ILEAS:

- \$7,900 to cover May through June 2018
- \$4,050 per month from July 2018 through June 2019
- \$4,100 per month from July 2019 through June 2020
- \$4,150 per month from July 2020 through June 2021

The annual budget ranges from \$48,600 to \$49,800 per year for a total of \$155,500 over three years. This contract can be terminated by either party with a 60-day written notice.

Requested Board Action

Staff requests that the Board authorize the Executive Director to enter into the contract with the Illinois Coroners' Training Board for web and LMS services.
