- Discussion of Motion- Tim Swanson- SOS Photo Enhancement line item, what does it entail. Kirk Lonbom with ISP noted it is a system to help insure interoperability between State systems for driver's licesence pictures. This is State Homeland Security monies not Law Enforcement Terrorism monies.
- \$140,000 tabled DHS Equipment Grant (Tabled by President)
- Presentations
  - Kirk Lonbom gave an ICLEAR overview and update of the system. He gave a presentation to the ITTF yesterday on the new credentialing system. ISP is testing in beta-state right now and is testing the interfaces of the system.

- ICLEAR is also in beta-state testing and starting to expand to local agencies soon (contact Kirk if you want to participate)
- The data warehouse is also in beta-state and has 150 users currently.
- The credentialing program is currently in beta-state, but should be in pilotstate in the next few days. The next step is from pilot-state to active-state.
- ISP needs a motion to approve expenditures that they need for the Credentialing system to sync up with the Federal System.
