INVITATION FOR BIDS FOR NARCAN NASAL SPRAY

January 28, 2021

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I. INTRODUCTION AND PROJECT DESCRIPTION

ILEAS is a Public Agency of the State of Illinois created by various local law enforcement agencies throughout the State of Illinois pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/1 et seq.).

ILEAS through a grant provided by Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) provides NARCAN Nasal Spray to Police and Fire agencies in Illinois.

ILEAS is in the process of selecting a vendor to provide 2 pack boxes of 4mg NARCAN Nasal Spray with a three year shelf life not to exceed a total purchase price of \$166,500.

The IFB responses will provide ILEAS with proposals to evaluate and select a vendor to provide the required NARCAN Nasal Spray. This IFB outlines the overall objectives and expectations of the contract and will provide ILEAS with the required information such that ILEAS can make an informed and prudent decision for the acquisition of the product described herein.

II. GENERAL CONDITIONS

By submitting a response to this IFB the Respondent agrees to all of the following:

- A. ILEAS reserves the right to award or cancel this procurement process at any time.
- B. ILEAS is not bound to accept the lowest bid, nor any proposal submitted.
- C. Failure to meet the response delivery date may be basis for disqualification of the Respondent proposal.
- D. Respondents are fully responsible for all costs, both direct and indirect, of development and submission of their response to this IFB, including, but not limited to, any supplementary documentation, information, travel, and presentation expenses.
- E. ILEAS will only accept proposals submitted by email.
- F. ILEAS will maintain sole ownership of responses after submission.
- G. Respondents agree that submission of a proposal warrants acceptance of the above general terms and considerations and guaranteed pricing until September 30th, 2021.
- H. The successful applicant may also be required to present additional documentation/or information necessary to determine financial and programmatic capability.

Efforts will be made by ILEAS to utilize small business, women and/or minority owned businesses. An applicant qualifies if it meets the definition of "small business" as established by the Small Business Administration (13 CFR § 121.201)

ILEAS is seeking the following product from one or more vendors\contractors.

2 pack boxes of NARCAN Nasal Spray 4mg with a 3 year shelf life from date of Manufacture: Total cost not to exceed \$166,500

Requirement A - Product drop shipped to ILEAS 1701 E Main Street, Urbana IL 61802

Requirement B - Complete order shipped within 10 days of order placed

Information C - Payment is made through a reimbursement process with the State of Illinois. Payment to vendor could be significantly longer than 30 days.

Requirement D - IFB must include all costs in detail necessary to calculate a complete price for this IFB. For example but not necessarily complete: product cost per 2 pack box, shipping and handling, and any costs related to potential extended payment schedule.

Requirement E – IFB must include approximate date of manufacture and date of expiration for proposed product.
